



How to access Daymap


1. Type the following URL into an Internet search engine:





Learning Intent

- Students will be reviewing their assessment results from last weeks in class activity in Daymap
- Students will be learning the basics of coding using ode.org and MineCraft .

Watch activity video on projector and discuss

Stop at activity 6 and review the build routine in Minecraft. Complete activity 6 on interactive projector as class group.





As long as a word document has been uploaded, then students will successfully complete the task. Students will be able to see their result in Daymap after 8am on Tuesday 5th of June.




After you click My Work, you will be taken to this screen to find the file.

4. Click Open




After you click open, you will return to the **My Work** screen and your uploaded file will show.
