Beerwah State High School will invoice and accept payment for a variety of purposes including school fees, excursions, special events and fundraising opportunities. Please note that due dates, payment plan instalments and general financial obligations are standard, no matter your preferred method of payment.

Beerwah State High School is transitioning to be a cashless school. While cash, cheque and EFTPOS are still currently available, we also offer multiple alternative payment options including online gateways for families:

## **BPOINT**

- Secure online and telephone banking payment gateway
- Payments are made directly through BPOINT – no contact with school payment office required
- Link your Debit or Credit Card in a secure environment
- Undertake transactions at your own convenience
- Link to BPOINT gateway and all required transaction information including CRN, Invoice Number and Amount are provided on invoices
- Payment Plan instalments can be set up. Set and forget

## **QParents**

- Secure mobile and online payment and student information platform
- Payments made directly via the app – no contact with school payment office required
- Undertake transactions at your convenience
- Make payment against a variety of fees and events
- No Invoice Numbers or CRN required
- A variety of student information is also accessible via the app including attendance, timetables, report cards and calendar of events
- Contact the Front Office to register for QParents

- Secure mobile application payment gateway developed by CBA
- Make payment against a variety of fees and events in a single transaction
- Link your Debit or Credit Card in a secure environment
- Undertake transactions at your own convenience
- No invoice numbers, CRN needed
- Download the app, search for Beerwah SHS. Our profile is currently being designed and will be available to access by January 2022

## **CentrePay**

- Secure online payment facility
- Used for Payment Plan instalments, not one-off transactions
- Can be set up by families or the school
- Accessible for families receiving payments through Department of Human Services
- Once set up, no further contact required with school payment office unless cancelling or amending payments

## **EFTPOS, Cash, Cheque**

- Will continue to be accepted in 2022 while we fully transition to previously mentioned payment methods
- Make payment for a variety of fees and events in a single transaction
- Can be used to make payment against Payment Plan instalments
- Must come in to the school each time
- Risk of loss of cash/card
- Payment over the phone is available by calling 1300 276 498. To make payment via this method, you must have all transaction details including Invoice Number, CRN and Amount
